Aura were appointed by Newcastle City Council for the delivery of a new build first school for 150 pupils in the Newcastle Great Park Area.

The design works were commissioned by the Authority prior to incorporation of Aura, and as such the Authority continued with the design using Aura to deliver the build.

As part of a major residential development a school was included to support the local community. Brunton First School comprises of state of the art classrooms and a series of flexible learning spaces. The new build includes two multi-purpose halls, a studio and a food technology room.





In addition, a large learning resource area which houses a library, an ICT centre and areas for small group learning was included within the project.

The outside spaces cover four acres and include a football pitch and mutli-use games area, a playground and gardens.

The project was completed on time and to a high standard. Energy grants of £30k for the Authority were secured by Aura enabling greater investment in the project.
