Hampton by Hilton Completes

Aura recently handed over Teesside's first Hampton by Hilton hotel which is now open for business at Stockton-on-Tees. Aura was originally appointed by Stockton Borough Council via the NEPO framework to deliver the multi-disciplinary team for the development of the 128 bed, seven storey hotel.
