Current Projects



Teesside University - National Horizons Centre

The £22.3M project has been let to Wates Construction and work started on site in January 2018, completing early 2019. Aura is proud to be working on this project in partnership with Summers Inman.



Civic Centre Refurbishment

Planning approval has been achieved for Phase 2. Works are due to start in spring 2018. Sir Robert McAlpine have been selected as preferred bidder and dialogue is ongoing for second stage tender. The Aura team continue to support Newcastle City Council with HMCTS to agree the tenancy.



Northshore Hotel

The hotel is a 128 bed, seven storey Hampton by Hilton hotel which is situated on a prominent site in Stockton on Tees, overlooking the riverside. The project represents the next phase of development in the Northshore masterplan and will be a significant boost to the local economy. Building works commenced on site in November 2017 and are due to be completed late 2018 / early 2019.



Teesside University - Library Refurbishment

Teesside University £7M library refurbishment was complete for September 2017.

Darren Vipond, Director, Campus Services, Teesside University, said: "Aura has supported the University on a variety of capital projects over the last 5 years, their approach is flexible & adaptable and we have found the service they offer to be a good fit to our strategy and delivery requirements."



Newcastle Laboratory Science City

Concept design works commenced autumn 2015 with construction works starting on site November 2016. Works are progressing well on site and due to complete spring 2018.

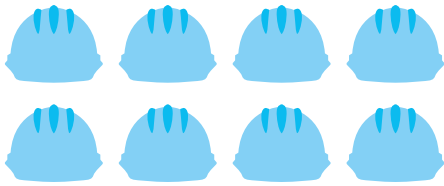

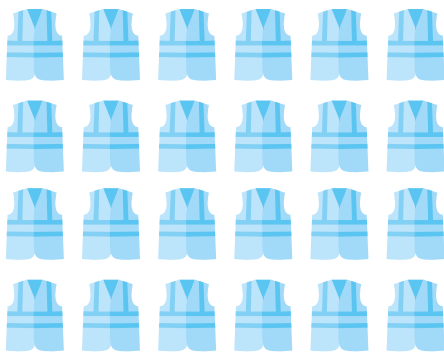
