Aura were appointed by Newcastle City Council for the delivery of a new build extension comprising of 4 new early years' classrooms, allowing the school to increase their pupil capacity.

The extension was designed and project managed by Aura to adhere to a strong school vision which focussed upon functionality and external appearance.

Aura worked with all parties to develop a design which was economically viable but provided a high end service for users.

The Aura team provided project management and contract administration during the length of the project, and liaised directly with both Newcastle City Council and the school every step of the way.

The refurbishment resulted in minimal disruption for the school as all works were carried out during term time and were completed in time for the pupils to return back to school.



The additional space created by the extension allowed the school to increase their pupil capacity from 300 - 500.

The new use of space offered a state of the art learning environment that will transform the school from a one form entry to a two form entry school and will provide the pupils with space to grow and learn.
