Aura were appointed by Newcastle City Council to carry out a site analysis at Sir Charles Parsons School to identify where additional teaching space could be added to the existing site to accommodate an increase in pupil numbers in post 16.

Working with the school and Newcastle City Council, an area of the existing hard play was selected for its proximity to the existing school building but suitably independent for new dedicated post 16 teaching provision through a design and build scheme.

The project delivered 2 bespoke classrooms outwith the main school building which formed the post 16 additional space. The classrooms were accessed using a dedicated entrance encouraging independence for pupils as they progress through the school. All doors were fitted with powered automatic access.

A large teaching kitchen with height adjustable hob and sink were located within 1 of the classrooms whilst the other formed the style of a standard classbase. Both spaces were equipment with high quality ICT.

Work is now underway to transform the remaining hard play area with new surfacing and markings.

The Aura team provided design and build, project management and quantity surveying services during the length of the project, and liaised directly with both Newcastle City Council and the school every step of the way.

The school are delighted with their new facility and plan to commence using this from January 2021.
